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OUR SERVE GROUP COVENANT

Read this together as a group, then sign below. Keep it somewhere your team will see it — a group chat pin, a fridge, a car visor.

- We will serve together on a regular rhythm — monthly, at minimum — and treat it as a standing commitment, not a someday plan.
- We will pray for the people and places we serve, by name, before and after each project.
- We will show up on time, follow through on what we sign up for, and communicate early if plans change.
- We will look for ways to invite others into what we're doing — this group grows by welcome, not recruitment.
- We will keep the focus on the people we're serving, not on ourselves.

LEADER ROLE GUIDE

A Serve Group doesn't need a big team — but spreading these four roles across a few people keeps any one person from carrying it all.

GROUP LEADER

Owns the group's rhythm and keeps everyone moving toward the next project.

- Picks or confirms the monthly project
- Leads the group covenant conversation for new members
- Runs point on the day of the project

COMMUNICATIONS POINT PERSON

Makes sure nobody finds out about a project too late to plan around it.

- Sends the reminder 1 week and 1 day before each project
- Keeps the group chat or email list current
- Follows up with anyone who missed the last project

SUPPLIES COORDINATOR

Turns the planning template's supply list into things that actually show up.

- Confirms who's bringing what before the day of
- Tracks what the group already owns vs. needs to buy or borrow
- Handles reimbursement or budget requests

PRAYER COORDINATOR

Keeps the group's heart in the right place, not just its logistics.

- Opens and closes each project with prayer
- Collects prayer requests from the people being served, where appropriate
- Follows up on requests at the next gathering

SUPPLY CHECKLIST

A starting point for the most common Serve Group projects. Check off what applies, cross out what doesn't.
